Restoring an American Icon

The story of the faithful restoration of a Pullman Rail Car

Pullman Standard. The name is synonymous with elegance, refinement and luxury, and represents the pinnacle of customer service in the late 19th century and early decades of the 20th. After service ended Pullman cars were sold to different lines and to private owners, traveling all across the country logging many miles and were beginning to show their age.

Return to the present day where the dream of Edwin E. Ellis, President of Iowa Pacific Holdings, LLC, began to revive that high standard of excellence, but how? Slowly and selectively, Pullman cars were purchased amassing a group that rivaled any privately-owned passenger car collection in existence. Each car had traveled its own trails, developed its own personality and, all assembled, have quite the story to tell. They were bought to work together, but first they needed to return to the same quality of their original design. Come along and hear how one car made that transformation.

Our story begins back in 1956 when an eleven double bedroom sleeper car named the Tallahassee was built by Pullman Standard. It was promptly put to work for Seaboard Air Line, an unusually named railroad, accommodating overnight passengers in classic Pullman comfort. Later, the car moved to Seaboard Coast Line and the sleeper was in service between northeastern cities - primarily New York - to major points on both coasts of Florida including the cities of Miami and Tampa. During the slower summer season in Florida, the Tallahassee traveled west to spend time on the California Zephyr line between Chicago and San Francisco.

The Tallahassee was acquired by Amtrak in 1971, and then eight years later it was sold to a succession of private owners, and at one time was renamed the Blue Bonnet. The car was owned for almost a decade by American Orient Express and logged over 700,000 miles. Aged by over a half century of use, the car was eventually purchased by Iowa Pacific Holdings in 2010 where the restoration team in Alamosa, Colorado worked diligently to return the car to its full potential meeting high Pullman standards.

In June of 2012, the interior hardware, sofas and chairs were all taken out and every inch was sanded down and repainted in historical Pullman colors. The walls were returned to their original sand color and the doors were painted coral on one side and teal on the other. The white brass locks, which are a combination of brass and nickel, were all hand buffed to their original shine. Every sofa and chair was reupholstered in custom-ordered fabrics that matched the original color and texture, but met new FRA standards (sorry, no mohair allowed). Modern air conditioning, wiring and a conversion of a general toilet to a shower space were the only changes to the faithful restoration.

Four and a half months later the car was restored to its former glory, renamed the Baton Rouge and brought to Chicago for Pullman Rail Journeys. Come ride this piece of living history, hear the many miles traveled in its lifetime with each click of the track and see why it was a treasure worth restoring and adding to the collection.

How Great Food Comes from a Small Kitchen

Sit Down with Chef Dan Traynor

Challenges abound in any restaurant kitchen, but the unique trials of cooking on a railcar are something few chefs must face. One of the pinnacles of Pullman standards of service is the impeccable food options available to guests. Taking great time and care to not only recreate dishes served aboard Pullman dining cars in the early 20th century, but to adapt them for modern tastes was a special project for Chef Traynor and is now a labor of love.

How big is your railcar kitchen compared to a restaurant kitchen?

Compared to some of the kitchens I've worked in, it's 1/20 of the size. But I'm still surprised at what we can pull off in such a small space.

What has to be left out due to space considerations?

We have pretty much all the standard equipment you'd find in a commercial kitchen, some of it on a much smaller scale though. The biggest challenge is refrigeration space; on most cars, there's little more than a standard home refrigerator.

Is it harder working in a compact kitchen or working aboard a moving train?

You actually learn to be rather efficient in such a small space. When you go back to a restaurant, you sometimes feel spoiled. The movement does take some getting used to, but after a few burns and cuts, you adjust.

How do you define the Pullman dining experience?

Classic American comfort foods executed for modern tastes.

How do you select the menus that are in keeping with the high standards of the Pullman name with these limitations? The equipment we are currently using is not that different from what was once used. Looking back at old railroad recipes, you realize how much of our modern cuisine was built on this foundation.

Is it difficult to design menus that hearken to the sophisticated golden age of rail travel yet satisfy modern palates?

There are definitely challenges. When a recipe calls for American cheese or a packet of pudding mix, you have to figure out how to keep with the idea of the recipe while updating for the modern palate.

Do the departure towns of Chicago and New Orleans influence the menus?

Yes and no. We take a lot of our recipes from the Illinois Central, which ran the City of New Orleans. However, when you have two great food towns like Chicago and New Orleans, it's hard not to let it influence the food a little, even if it's just in how you source your ingredients.

What made you want to take on this unique challenge?

There's something about working on trains that really sings to me. When you're going 80 mph and you are the chef, sous chef, dishwasher, prep cook, line cook and dishwasher, you really have to have everything; you are focused on that meal service. Also, this is the kind of work atmosphere that isn't for everyone and doesn't lend itself well to people who just do this for the time being. I work with people that are passionate about service and hospitality, and their intensity is just amplified by the fact that we do it in a steel box at 80 mph.

LARGEST PULLMAN CAR RESTORATION UNDERTAKING

Pullman Rail Journeys are appropriately based out of Chicago, home to the original Pullman Company that, at its peak in the 1930's, was an empire for building and operating a fleet of the nation's finest passenger rail cars. There are 500 known Pullman Rail Cards in North America, of which 200 are heavyweights and 300 are lightweights. Iowa Pacific Holdings, LLC (IPH) currently owns 70 Pullman Rail Cars, located around the country, rescued from freight yards and backyards all over America, including Alaska. Six Pullman Rail Cars have been pulled from Iowa Pacific Holdings' collection to be restored for the initial journey, with other distinguished cars waiting in the wings to be restored and added through expanded offerings.

The Pullman Rail Journey consist includes recycled, heavyweight cars as well as lightweight cars dating back to a 1917 round end sleeper-observation that was originally a coach built by the Pullman Company. Each car was carefully brought back to service and underwent painstakingly detailed restoration to be as historically accurate as possible including recreations of textiles, bedding, plates, utensils and company uniforms. Costs for restoration of each of these cars ranged from \$750,000 to \$1.2 million per car, depending on the degree of restoration required.

Credited with the creation of the first modern, comfortable sleeping car for rail travel in 1858, the Pullman name is synonymous with impeccable service and accommodations. While maintaining period appearance, mechanical improvements and contemporary upgrades were made to Pullman Rail Journeys cars to meet current standards and to maximize guest comfortthroughout every moment of a traveler's journey.

As the first cities in the Pullman Rail Journeys series, Chicago and New Orleans are expected to realize positive impact from:

- Materials purchases: Restoration materials, local grocery and uniform purchases; USA made when possible.
- Real estate investment: 14,000 square feet of space leased for the Pullman Rail Journeys' commissary in Chicago, with a five year contract and options to renew.
- Job creation: Approximately 20 fulltime operations employees including conductors, porters, waiters and engineers. Approximately eight fulltime employees for reservations and management functions.
- Incremental tourism revenue: Expected for lodging, transportation, dining, retail, entertainment in disembarkation cities.
- Recycling: Restoration of original cars and the use of original Pullman parts when possible.
- Additionally, several key trends in travel point to a positive economic outlook for Pullman Rail Journeys:
- The travel industry has recovered more than half of the jobs lost during the recession, a pace which exceeds the rest of the economy by 34 percent. Demand for service workers validates current demand and points to future growth.
- Foreign visitors to the U.S. were up 13.5 percent through the first 11 months of 2012, and New Orleans holds significant shares of international market travel.
- US domestic leisure travel is expected to increase +3.0% in 2012 and +4.3% in 2013.
